# **WESTON DRAMA WORKSHOP**

## **ARTIST CONTRACT, GUIDELINES AND POLICIES**

The Weston Drama Workshop (WDW) Board of Directors is dedicated to the creation of a safe learning environment that encourages personal growth through age appropriate theatrical workshops and productions. The Workshop's professional and volunteer staff provides guidance for students within a positive, social atmosphere. The following rules and expectations are established in that spirit and must be adhered to for the enjoyment and safety of all workshop members. **All participants must sign the contract following this document to signify understanding of rules and expectations for WDW.**

**HOURS OF WORKSHOPS** All rehearsals and performances will be held at Regis College. Please see detailed calendar for each show. Workshops will be held as scheduled around the July 4<sup>th</sup> holiday. Note that during "Tech Week" (the week just prior to productions), hours are variable, may be longer and are subject to change. In general, hours for each workshop are:

AM Workshop - HONK!:

Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. Participants must bring their own lunch.

Afternoon Workshop (Theater for Young Audiences)- Alicia in Wonder Tierra:

Monday through Friday, 1:30pm to 5:30pm

The week of 7/12 - 7/16, workshop runs 5:00pm - 8:00pm

PM Workshop - Children of Eden and The 25th Annual Putnam County Spelling Bee:

Sunday through Thursday, 6:30 p.m. to 10:30 p.m.

Tech Workshop

Sunday through Thursday, 5:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m.

Pick-up Time:

**It is imperative that you pick up your child or carpool on time at the conclusion of rehearsal. There is no supervision after the end of rehearsal.**

*Note: There is minimal cell phone service at Regis College. If you need to reach your child, call the Regis College Box Office at 781-768-7070.*

***Important:***

- ♦ Please arrive ½ hour before your audition, and allow 2 hours for the audition itself. You will be asked to sing, move and act. Everyone will be taught a song from the show, but you may also bring a prepared solo (please bring sheet music for the accompanist).
  - ♦ Bring a listing of any prior theater, music or dance experience.
  - ♦ Wear comfortable clothing and bring dance shoes or sneakers. **DO NOT WEAR SANDALS OR FLIP-FLOPS.**
- You will be notified during the audition if you need to return for callbacks. Registrants who audition will be notified of casting by phone during the week following final callbacks.

**ATTENDANCE is mandatory at ALL workshops, rehearsals and performances.** For PM show and Tech participants, attendance at Strike on Sunday, July 25<sup>th</sup> is also mandatory.

**Workshop and performance schedules for each workshop are provided in this packet. These schedules are subject to change.** If an unexpected absence occurs, you must call the Regis College Box Office at 781-768-7070. Unscheduled absence for anything besides sickness can result in re-casting or removal from scenes.

## HEALTH AND EMERGENCY GUIDELINES

### Health and Emergency Fact Sheet

**This form must be submitted before the first workshop.** Any allergies, medications, physical limitations and medical conditions must be documented. A First Aid kit is available for minor injuries. In the event of injury or illness during workshop, we will call the emergency contact listed. This information is critical.

### Prescription Medications

Medications that need to be taken during workshop hours need to be kept in the box office in the original container with the prescription name, dosage, any instructions, and the doctor's name on the container. The box office must be advised if your child will be taking medication during the program. All medication must be retrieved by the student from the box office to ensure the safety of all participants.

## RULES FOR BEHAVIOR

1. Courtesy towards all WDW members is expected without exception.
2. Since other programs/classes are sharing the premises, access is limited to the following:  
At *Weston High School* (where auditions are held), WDW members are permitted in the:
  - Auditorium Lobby and Hallway
  - Black Box / Dance Studio
  - Restrooms
  - Scenery Workshop
  - Auditorium and Stage
  - Media Center
  - Dressing RoomsAt *Regis College*, WDW members are permitted in the:
  - Lobby
  - Green Room
  - Black Box
  - Auditorium and Stage
  - Costume Shop
  - Hallway backstage
  - Bathrooms off Green Room and off Lobby
  - Scenery Workshop***ALL OTHER AREAS ARE OFF LIMITS!***
3. Food or drinks are allowed in the lobby and outside only. Please be considerate; pick up after yourself!
4. For safety reasons, do not touch power tools, technical equipment or sets unless directed to do so.
5. Respect for costumes and props is of the utmost importance. Do not touch costumes or props unless directed to do so.
6. Sneakers, Jazz shoes or character shoes must be worn at all times. Open-toed shoes are not allowed unless part of a costume.
7. The auditorium must remain quiet while rehearsals are in progress.
8. Due to liability, only Weston Drama Workshop members will be allowed to attend workshops and rehearsals. Parents and guests are not permitted and will be asked to leave.

**TOBACCO POLICY:** Weston Drama Workshop has a zero tolerance policy for tobacco use on school grounds or within school buildings.

**DRUGS AND ALCOHOL POLICY:** Weston Drama Workshop has a zero tolerance policy regarding drugs and alcohol. Any participant of WDW found to be in possession of, or under the influence of alcohol, marijuana or any controlled and/or illegal substance will be subject to expulsion from the program with no refund.

**REFUND POLICY:** Prior to June 1st, a refund of 100% minus \$75 registration can be issued. **After June 1st, there will be NO REFUNDS.** Please email WDW for refund information if needed.
